WELCOME

State Law

Effective beginning the 2018-2019 school year, a new amendment on Texas state law 28.025 subsection b-21, allows students who successfully complete a dual language immersion program in elementary (K-5) school to receive one foreign language high school credit.



What Does This Mean for my student?

As a result, any student who successfully completes the K-5 dual language program at LEISD will receive

one world languages credit with a

passing score in their high school transcript.



What is a Passing Score, and will it affect their Grade Point Average?

A passing score has **no weight** on a student's **GPA**. It simply recognizes that the student has met the criteria to earn the credit.



What Do You Mean by “successfully completes”?

It simply means that the student **finished** their **5th** grade passing all their classes.



What Options Will my Student have next year?

Spanish Business Management & Entrepreneurship

Bilingual Education

General Medical with a Spanish Concentration



Spanish Business

Management & Entrepreneurship

During their senior year, students in this pathway will serve a practicum in business with a Latino presence

with the purpose of using their **cultural** and

language skills within the company.



Bilingual Education

At their senior level, the students in this program will do their practicum experience in a one-way or two-way **dual language classroom** within the district.



General Medical with Spanish Concentration

During their senior year, students will be expected to serve a healthcare practicum in a location where they can use their **cultural** and **language skills** within the clinic.



Are There Requirements for these programs?

To participate in these programs students will need to
be **enrolled** or have been enrolled in their
advanced Spanish language classes.



What Are Advanced Spanish language classes?

Any Spanish classes beyond Spanish II:

Spanish Pre-AP III or Heritage AP III

Spanish AP IV

Spanish Literature AP

*What if my Student Decides Not to
take Spanish II next year?*

Suggested pathway is **highly
recommended** but not mandatory.
