Policies & Procedures

Absent/Late Work Policy

Late Work – unless you have an extenuating circumstance, work that is not submitted by the beginning of class will be considered late and graded as follows:

1 Period or more Late – 10%

1 day late - 15%

2 days late - 25%

3 days late - 35%

After 3 days – ZERO

All late work must be submitted with a LATE FORM attached.

Absent Work – It is your responsibility to check the absent folders for any work you missed while you were absent. Late work due to a legal absence will not be penalized. You must fill out a late form and attach it to your assignment in order to receive a grade.

Tests & Quizzes – If student was in class the day before the scheduled test/quiz, student must complete it on the day of return. If student was absent the day before the scheduled test/quiz, student will be given the number of absent days to complete the exam.

Plagiarism Policy

Plagiarism is defined as taking someone's ideas and writings and presenting them as your own. Students caught plagiarizing will be given a ZERO for the assignment and parents and administration will be notified.
