## Advanced Placement (AP)

Rigorous academic program for hard-working, committed students

Innovative dual-enrollment program, high standards of University of Texas

### BENEFITS:

College courses in a supportive environment, LEHS teachers partner with UT Professors, \*Widely accepted transferable credits

## Dual Credit (DC)

College courses provided by partner institutions of higher education

### BENEFITS:

College course enrollment while also earning high school credit, headstart on post high school education

## Career and Technical Education (CTE)

Pathways that lead to certifications and/or DC courses

### BENEFITS:

Successful completion of specified pathways can lead to industry certifications/ \*college credit
