According to the laws of the State of Texas, every person paid for instructional work in the public schools must have registered a valid Texas Teacher's Certificate with the Superintendent of Schools of the District. An applicant must have at least a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. Exceptions to the degree rule may be made for teachers of vocational and trade classes who present trade and industrial training records in compliance with Texas Education Agency requirements. Graduates of a Texas college or university should contact the head of the education department of the college or university to secure a Texas Teaching Certificate.
